We encourage you to complete the DNA samples as soon as possible.

Collecting DNA

Swab: Swab the child's mouth with the end of the Q-tip and allow to air dry before sealing in the plastic bag.

Hair: Collect hair samples from your child's head or hairbrush making sure to include the root.

Fingernail Clippings: Collect fingernail clippings at bath time.

Parents: While completing the DNA process, talk with your child and explain why this is being done. This is also an excellent time to re-enforce safety and awareness.

Storage: Store DNA samples AT HOME in a cool, dry place, but DO NOT REFRIGERATE them. Do NOT take them on trips with you.
